Definitions:

Pennsylvania Resident: Any student who has established a domicile in Pennsylvania for at least 12 months prior to initial enrollment and whose presence in the state is not primarily for educational purposes.

Non-Resident: Any student whose presence in the Commonwealth is primarily for educational purposes.

Domicile: Is a person's existing and intended, fixed, permanent and principal place of residence.

Policy:

- I. Resident status is designated at the time of enrollment.
- II. A student under the age of 21 is presumed to have the domicile of his/her parent(s) or legal guardian, unless the student has maintained continuous residence in Pennsylvania for purposes other than education for a period of at least 12 months prior to initial enrollment at Penn College, and provided the student continues to maintain such separate residence.
- III. A student who has resided in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for other than educational purposes for at least a period of 12 months immediately preceding his/her initial enrollment at Penn College is presumed to have a Pennsylvania domicile.
- IV. A United States government employee or member of the armed forces who was a resident of Pennsylvania immediately preceding his/her entry into governmental services, and who has continuously maintained Pennsylvania as his/her home of residency, will be presumed to have a

Pennsylvania domicile. Military personnel and their dependents assigned to active duty in Pennsylvania and reside in this state shall be considered Pennsylvania residents for tuition purposes

- V. A student receiving a scholarship, guaranteed loan, grant, or other form of financial assistance dependent upon residence in a state other than Pennsylvania is not a Pennsylvania resident for tuition purposes.
- VI. Students may appeal for reclassification of their residency for tuition purposes as established in Procedure 4.18.
